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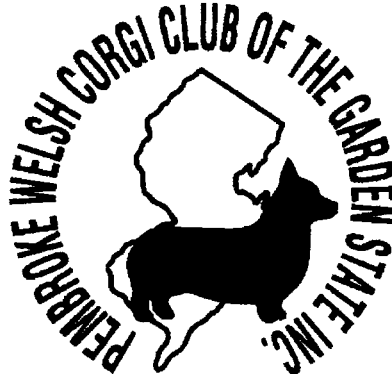

**CLOSING DATE** for entries 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, April 16, 2008 (at Show Secretary's Office) after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

**THE SHOW AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL** will be open from May 1, 2 & 3rd - 7:00am-7:00pm.

**An AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a **\$20.00 collection fee** to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.**

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

**ALL CREDIT CARD ENTRIES, REGARDLESS OF METHOD SUBMITTED,** are processed through the Fax program and will be charged a \$4.00 per dog per show convenience fee.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows, Ltd., Show Superintendent (610) 376-1880.

**MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO** J.R.D.S., Ltd. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS** make fees payable in **U.S. FUNDS.**

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.**

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES & TROPHIES** will be given in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money or trophies must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes or trophies after the judging of the breed is over. No award will be mailed.

**THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SHOW SECRETARY** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

**CLEAN UP:** Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in and around their set-up and at the show site.

**NO GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$4.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The show secretary must be notified of such claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked by May 1, 2008 or earlier. Veterinarian's certificate required.
