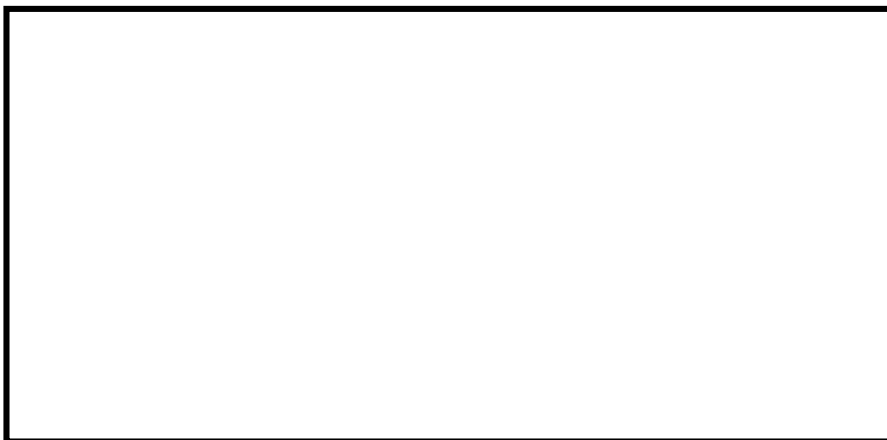

**Canine Courtesy:** All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates at all times except when competing. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care. It is expressly understood that every dog at this trial is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises. PWCCGS is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause.

Dogs entered and handlers are permitted on the trial grounds on Thursday October 7, 2004 at 6PM. Anyone found to be practicing on trial equipment may be barred from the trial. No exhibitors will be allowed in the trial ring without permission. Exhibitors are permitted in the rings only at scheduled times for course familiarization, walk throughs, etc.

**Exercise Equipment:** A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided. No other warm up equipment is allowed in the trial area.

**Motor Homes/Trailers:** Overnight parking is available for \$10.00 a night. **However, reservations must be made in advance (October 1, 2004) so that permits can be obtained from the park.** Vehicles must be self-contained. ## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. All classes will be held outdoors in a ring with grass footing. The size of the ring will be 100' x 110'.
2. All dogs twelve (12) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration are eligible to participate.
3. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
4. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate. After the closing of entries, owners wishing a refund of entries, subject to a \$5.00 secretarial fee, must present a veterinarian's statement that the bitch is and will be in season on the dates of the trial. Veterinarian's statements must be in the hands of the trial secretary prior to the start of judging of the trial.
5. At the handler's option dogs may wear flat buckle collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
6. Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class.
7. Dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made, in writing, to the trial secretary not later than Monday, October 4, 2004 at 12:00PM. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order.
8. The regulations for Agility Trials are available from the American Kennel Club, 51 Madison Ave., New York, NY 10010.  
Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with the rules and regulations.
9. There is little shade and no protection from the weather at the trial site. Please bring tents, shade clothes, chairs, etc to make your day more comfortable for you and your dog. Bring water for your dog(s).
10. Food will be available for purchase the day of the show.

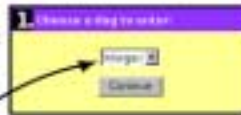

Declining of Entries: The Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of the Garden State may

*decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the American Kennel Club.*

- Make all checks and money orders payable to PWCCGS, Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Mail checks or money order with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- **Entries:** Telegraph, Telephone, and Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Entries can be made at DogEventsOnLine.com. They will be confirmed immediately when paid for on-line at this site.
- No Entries shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **Entry Fees:** shall *not* be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- **Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$30.00 to each returned check.
- Height at withers must be indicated on entry blanks as well as jump height.
- Exhibitors are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing of entries.
- No refund on duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- Please include a copy of your AKC Height card with your entry. If a copy is not received, you must present the official card at check-in or the dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in any class.





## **AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. ## **INSTRUCTIONS**

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
